SUMMARY:

This Scripture shows us what happens when we make our purpose, our vision, our goals, and our plan for our life subject to the world instead of fulfilling God's purpose, vision, goal, and plan for us.

DISCUSSION POINTS:

4 questions: Every man will have a personal answer for that is different from one another. They are God's "fingerprints" for every man or woman.

1. What is God's purpose for your life?
2. What is God's vision for your life?
3. What is God's goal for your life?
4. How does God give you a plan to use in order to accomplish these 3 things?

APPLICATION:

Since God already sees these goals already fulfilled in your life, you must also know that He has equipped you to be successful in accomplishing that which He put you here to do. You must seek the Holy Spirit daily about His goals and be committed to never ever quit.

Seek God to find your personal purpose, vision, goals, and plan instead of seeking the worlds way of success that will not outlast you.
