Joseph and his wife had two sons before the famine began. Their first son was named Manasseh, which means, "God has let me forget all my troubles and my family back home." His second son was named Ephraim, which means "God has made me a success in the land where I suffered."
Genesis 41:50-52 See also Genesis 41:38-52

SUMMARY:

Because God is a loving God, and those who follow Him in faith are his children, He does provide the things we need. There are times that we ask for things and the Lord does not seem to “get the job done” on our timetable or in our way. God is waiting for us to look deeper into His heart and discover that He holds a greater gift. God wants to give us a greater revelation of Himself. This is a provision that will never fade; one that will change us forever!

- ☑ Make a list of 5 ways that God has already provided for you beyond what you could have imagined. Thank Him!
