Proverbs 2

SUMMARY:

In every family and in every life there are many opportunities to make choices. Our lives are the result of the choices we make.

“You can choose the choice, but you can’t choose the consequence!”

NOTES:

Proverbs 2 tells us that we have the power to make choices. The choices we make can either save us or destroy us.

The chapter gives an example of the kind of choice that can bring destruction.

All of us could tell of choices that we or people we know have made and the results of those choices, either good or bad.

Joshua 24:15

Romans 6:16

DISCUSSION POINTS:

Introductory Question: Would anyone at our table be willing to tell of a choice you have been faced with and how it turned out, either for good or for bad?

Discussion: The second half of Proverbs 2 gives the example of following the “immoral woman” and how that leads to death. Can you think of any other choices you can make that could lead to spiritual death in your life?

Do any of the examples Randy gave remind you of any choices and consequences you have faced in your life or family?

Read Romans 6:16 and rephrase its meaning for your life.

Read Proverbs 2:11 – How has this applied in your life?

APPLICATION:

Determine that as you face the choices life offers you that you will make them with the wisdom of the Word of God. Fill your life, your mind and your heart with the Bible, God’s Word. It will give you the wisdom you need to make the right decision every time you are faced with a major choice.

Determine that you will influence others, especially those in your family, to learn how to make the right choices with the wisdom of God’s Word.

ON YOUR OWN...

Read and study Proverbs chapter 2. If you have a study Bible, read the notes in the margin.

Allow God to speak to you through the reading and make written notes to yourself as to how the passage applies to your life specifically.
