“The Origin of Wisdom”

Vs 4: “To you, O men, I call, and my voice is to the sons of men.”

Vs 10 & 11: “Take my instruction, and not silver, And Knowledge rather than choicest gold. For wisdom is better than jewels; And all desirable things can not compare with her.”

Vs 13: “The fear of the Lord is to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way, And the perverted mouth I hate.”

Vs 17: “I love those who love me; And those who diligently seek me will find me.”

SUMMARY:

“Blessed is the man who listens to me, Watching daily at my gates,
Waiting at my doorposts.”

DISCUSSION POINTS:

Introductory Question: Have you heard the “VOICE” of God during our studies of the book of Proverbs? HOW?

- Exodus 19:5 “If you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant” How do **YOU** obey the voice of God?
- Do you take instruction well?
- What was your response the last time you were reprimanded?
- Is wisdom more important to you than Silver and Gold?
- Is my heart in the right condition to hear the voice of God?

 - Time set aside to LISTEN.(Mark 4:23; Matt 11:15; Matt 13:9)
 - Uninterrupted prayer time (Matt 14:23)
