SUMMARY:

APPLICATION:

- Spend twenty minutes together daily for thirty days and discuss some of the questions at the end of chapter 9 in *Man in the Mirror*.
- What are three to five things you really like about your marriage. Share them with your spouse.
- Watch the movie *Fireproof* and discuss it together.
- Pray with your wife apart from meals at least 2x per wk. (put it on your calendar or in your phone as a recurring reminder and do it. If it was a tee time, none of us would miss it)
