Applications:

1. Love your wife by loving God first and then love God by loving your wife.
2. Love God by acknowledging Him and in the same way love your wife by acknowledging her.
3. Love God by listening to Him and in the same way love your wife by listening to her.
4. Love God by spending time with Him and in the same way love your wife by spending time with her.
5. Love God by adoring Him and in the same way love your wife by adoring her.
6. Love God by exalting Him and in the same way love your wife by exalting her.
