### SUMMARY:

We are created in God's own image (Gen.1:27) and God is a worker (Gen.1:1 – 2:3). Man was created for and designed to work (Gen.1:28, 2:15, 19-20, 3:19).

Our work is a calling. Webster defines "vocation" as a "calling to a particular state, business or profession". Just like many Pastors or Missionaries are "called" to full-time vocational service, we also have a calling in what we do.

We need to be Ambassadors for Christ in our work place. We must set an example by our work ethic, attitude toward our work and our co-workers, and be unashamed to share the Gospel of Jesus.
