SUMMARY:

**THE WISDOM OF GOD WILL PUT YOU ON A PATH TO
POWER AND PEACE!**

NOTES:

1. **THERE IS A DETOUR ON THE PATH TO POWER AND PEACE – THAT DETOUR IS PRIDE!**
2. **THE WISDOM OF GOD CAN LEAD TO POSITIONS OF POWER AND AUTHORITY!**
3. **ULTIMATELY, THE WISDOM OF GOD LEADS TO PEACE!**

DISCUSSION POINTS:

Introductory Question: Do you believe that God wants you to be in a position to influence others? Why or why not?

Discussion: - Tell us about a time when pride got you into trouble and caused you to lose influence.

- Why is wealth and power not a bad thing?
- Why is it important to follow God's plan to wealth and power?
- Have you ever struggled with maintaining peace in your life – and would it have anything to do with what we've talked about today?

APPLICATION:

- What "action items" do you need to put into your life schedule RIGHT NOW to CHANGE some of your practices that are not in line with what was taught today and get you on the path to power and peace?
- Will you commit yourself to a daily reading of the Bible, and read it as "The Word of God" to help you get and stay on the right path?
- Will you continue to allow yourself to be taught the Bible through Huddle and through a local church and/or Small Group to help you get and stay on path to leadership, influence and peace?

ON YOUR OWN...

Read and re-read Proverbs 14 – as you read, ask God to give you insight into the steps to take to get on and stay on the path to power and peace.

Talk openly with your spouse, or your friends, or your spiritual accountability partner about the points in this teaching. Be open to them telling you where you are passing and where you are falling short.
