DISCUSSION POINTS:

- What one thing in your life do you feel thwarts God’s plans most? (After each one has shared, pray for one another)

APPLICATION:

Ask yourself, “How can I be a part of God’s plan for my church body? Set up an appointment with your pastor to discuss the needs of your church as it strives to fulfill God’s plans.

Ask yourself: “How can I better align my life plans with God’s?”

Be open to what God wants to do?
