7. What blue-print or plan do you have in place to avoid regrets with your children? Grandchildren?

APPLICATION:

- Be open to making changes in your life you believe are necessary to avoid regrets with your children and/or grandchildren.

- Commit to praying daily by name for each of your children and/or grandchildren.
